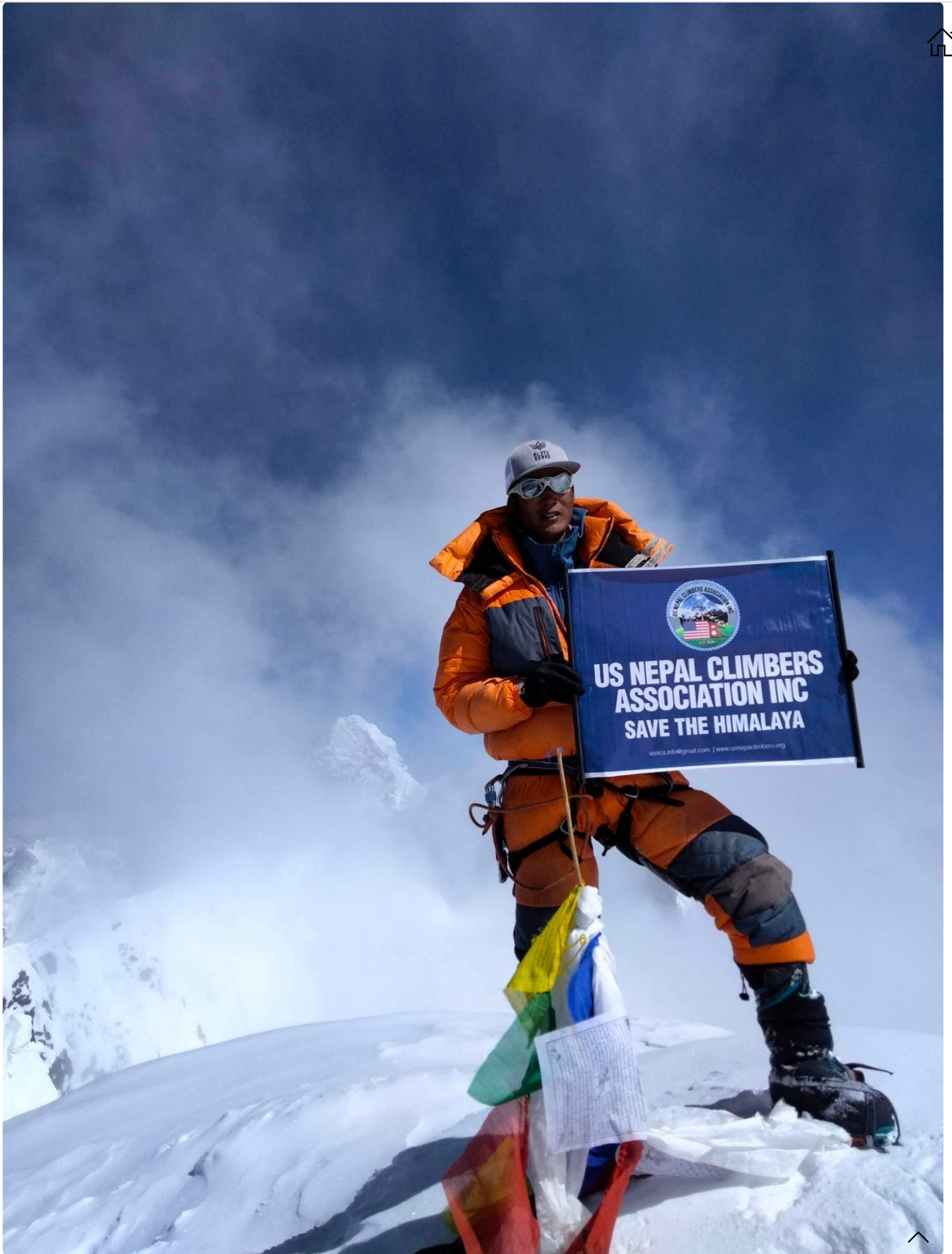
Karma Sherpa, who climbs Mount Everest twice in one week, climbs G1 and G2 in Pakistan

Mountaineer Karma Gelzen Sherpa is currently preparing for G1 and G2 climbs in Pakistan. After he climbs this, he will complete the climbing of all the 14 mountains above 8000 meters in the world. Mountaineer Karma is a royal climber who has climbed the highest peak Mount Everest 7 times and has climbed Mount Everest twice within a week. He has climbed Mt Everest twice within a week in 2019 and 2022. Similarly, Manaslu Himal and Amadblang were also climbed twice in one week.

He has been known as a famous mountaineer because of his heroic work in mountain climbing for a long time.



Born in Kharikhola, Pasangalhamu village, Solukhumbu district, Karma has also received the 'Tenzing Hillary' award in Nepal due to his indomitable courage in the field of climbing. He has so far managed to reach the highest peak Everest 7 times, Amadhablang 4 times, Manaslu 4 times, Lhotse 1 time and Mount Ketu and Broad Peak in Pakistan.

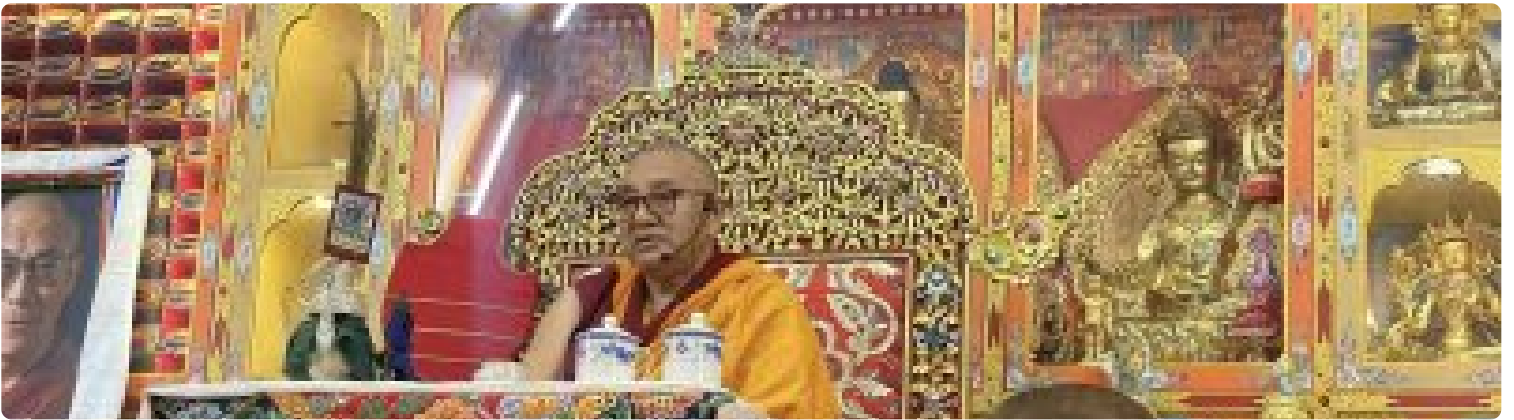

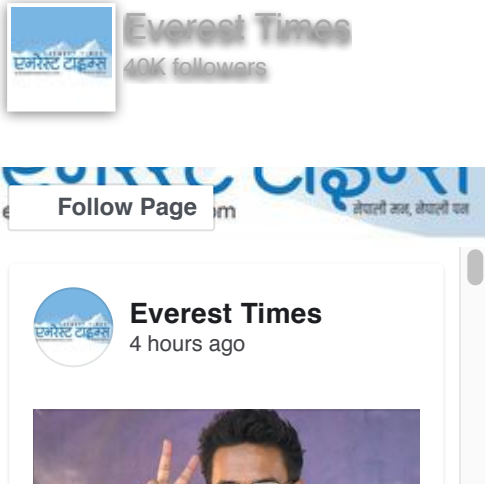
